ALTAR WORK

(Example of altar work: Luke 18:10-13)

A. Instructions for Altar Workers.

- 1. Be properly equipped with the right Scriptures for any type of person. Have an outline of the plan of Salvation in your Bible. (Use Bible Guide for Christian Workers, or Handbook for Christian Workers).
- 2. Go to service having the victory in your own heart and be prayed up.
- 3. Sit towards the back or in your assigned seat.
- 4. During the message the worker should be praying that God will move upon the unsaved and backslidden people in the audience.
- 5. When the call is given, bow your head but do not close your eyes-watch for hands.
- 6. Go at once to the one nearest you when seekers are asked to stand.
 - a. Go stand by his/her side or in back of him/her.
 - b. Say, "May I go with you to the altar?"
 - c. Reach out and offer to take his/her arm. That will encourage him/her to step out.
 - d. If he/she refuses to go forward, ask him/her if they really were in earnest when they raised their hand. After urging him/her further and giving him/her Genesis 6:3 and they still refuse, give him/her appropriate tracts and tell him/her you will be praying for them.

B. At the Altar.

First thing we must learn is that it is GOD who is to save them not us. We are only the instruments through which God works. The most important thing is for the soul to *find God*.
